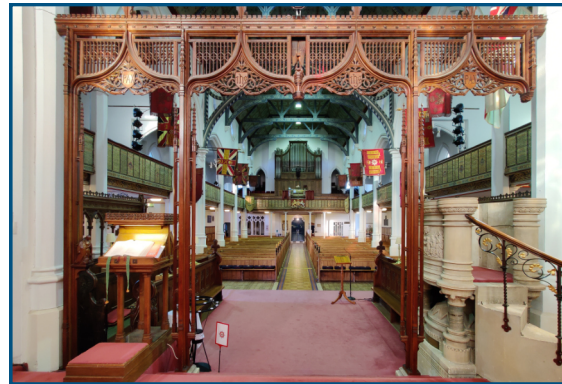

The Friends aim to contribute where possible:

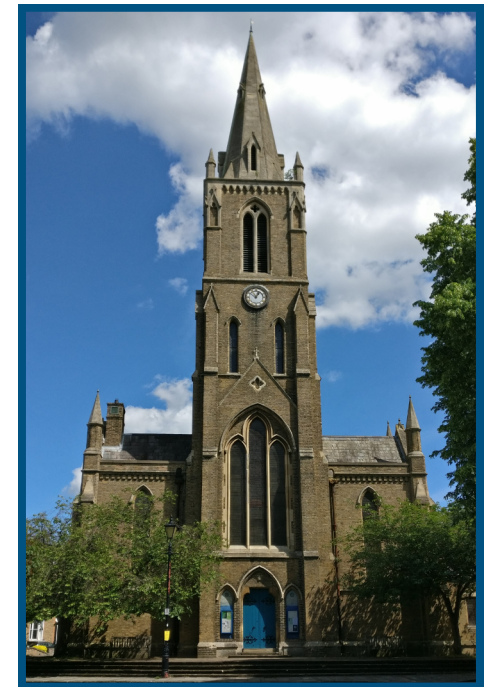
- Review and upgrade surrounding paving, over a period of time

Holy Trinity Church is probably unique in the UK. It was built to serve the military in two barracks and also the local community in its own parish, which stretched down to the banks of the Thames and the Castle.

However, the Church receives no money from the Crown, the Army, the Regiments, the Division, the Government or from the Church Of England. It has to be entirely self supporting.
