Maundy Thursday

As is our custom, this service will include the washing of feet and conclude with the stripping of the sanctuary and Watch of the Passion. Congregation members are invited to have their feet washed. Good Friday

Three Hour Devotion from 12 to 3pm at St John the Baptist. First Hour: Music for Passiontide; Second Hour: Meditations from Steven Cottrell's *The Things He Did*; Third Hour: Liturgy of the Cross. Stay for all three hours or come and go as you feel able.

This wonderful celebration of the resurrection begins this year at 6am and will be followed by breakfast.
